ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES ON THE ISSUANCE OF SALESPERSON'S LICENCES

- Any person who sells by going from place to place, or by the demonstration of samples, or by catalogue, in the Town of Hearst, must first obtain a salesperson's licence.
- 2. There are two types of salesperson's licence:
 - a) <u>Local salesperson:</u> "local" means the geographic region of Nord-Aski, which includes Hearst, Calstock, Hornepayne and Mattice, and the peripheral regions of those communities.
 - b) <u>Out-of-town</u> salesperson: "out-of-town" designates any area outside the geographic region of Nord-Aski.
- 3. A person who holds a Salesperson's licence:
 - a) may not store merchandise in a residential zone,
 - must deliver all merchandise sold to the residence of the buyer and no exchange of goods or money may be done at the salesperson's residence or in other residential locations.
 - c) may not erect a poster or advertising sign in a residential zone.
- 4. All salesperson's licences for the sale of **perishable** goods is subject to approval by the **Public Health Inspector**.
- 5. A salesperson's licence is not required to sell goods, articles or merchandise:
 - a) to retail or wholesale sellers of similar goods, product or merchandise,
 - b) if the said goods, product or merchandise are sold by a person who pays commercial taxes to the Municipality or his/her employee or agent,
 - c) for people who sell to the commercial, industrial and/or institutional sectors only.
- 6. The **cost** of a salesperson's licence is:

Local salesperson \$100.00 for 1 year

\$ 50.00 for 6 months

Out-of-town salesperson \$1,200.00 for 1 year

\$ 750.00 for 6 months
