

Re: Solid Waste Management

Here is a summary of municipal by-law No. 87-16 Solid Waste Management that has been adopted in first and second reading at the Council meeting on November 14th, 2016:

- Collection of refuse and recyling will be on an alternating weekly basis, one week for recycling, one week for refuse.
- One (1) 65 gallons container is equivalent to four (4) regular sized garbage bags (26" x 32.5"). One (1) 95 gallons container is equivalent to six (6) regular sized garbage bags (26" x 32.5").
- Subsection 2.33: Tax exempt properties will be ineligible to receive collection services.
- Subsection 3.5.6: On a specified day or time, objects may be placed on the curbside and may be removed by other residents of the Town for the purpose of reuse.
- Subsection 3.7.1 (ii): Each owner shall only utilise the approved container(s) for automated collection and semi-automated collection.
- Subsection 4.1: Maximum of one (1) 65 gallons container for refuse, and one (1) 95 gallons container for recycling per household.
- Subsection 4.2 4.3: Multi-residential building owners will have the option to purchase 65 and 95 gallons containers for refuse, in order to save space for collection. The limit of 65 gallons for refuse and 95 gallons recycling per household is still applicable. The amount of containers is to the owner's discretion. Semi-automated collection will be available with the help a cart tipper.

- Subsection 4.4: ICI (industrial, commercial, institutional) building owners will be allowed up to one (1) 95 gallons container for refuse and eight (8) 95 gallons containers for recycling.
 <u>Proposed change to subsection 4.4</u>: ICI building owners will be allowed up to eight (8) 95 gallons containers for refuse.
- Subsection 4.5: Businesses related to the food industry will be receiving a weekly collection, for refuse only, between June 1st and September 30th. Semi-automated collection will be available with the help of a cart tipper.
- Subsection 4.6: The Town shall provide an assisted waste collection program to an owner of a residential building, provided that the owner meets eligibility requirements.
- Subsection 8.1.4: Prohibited to deposit waste on any public or private property.
- Subection 8.1.10: Prohibited to burn waste within Town's limit.
- Appendix 02: A program will permit residents of the Town to deposit up to two (2) cubic yards, equivalent to a ½ ton truck load, free of charge.
- Appendix 03: Tipping fees at landfill site.
