



SUMMARY OF MUNICIPAL COUNCIL MEETING OF JULY 28, 2026

OPERATIONS

- Submission of a funding application under the Northern Ontario Resource Development Support Fund for the Gaspésie Road rehabilitation project, from Hwy 583 South to Bégin Road.
- Authorization to execute an agreement with Villeneuve Construction Co. Ltd. for the stabilization work on Blais, Roy and McNee Roads, at a cost of \$259,879.05 + HST, and to approve an additional budget allocation of \$23,000 to cover the project's shortfall, financed from the contingency fund included in the 2026 budget.
- Award of the contract for the supply of screened sand for the Municipality's winter operations to Villeneuve Construction Co. Ltd., at a unit price of \$28.80, for a total amount of \$51,840 + HST.

PARKS AND RECREATION

- Free use of La Limite Hall to the Hearst Minor Hockey Association for its training camp and its 2026-27 season tournaments, subject to existing municipal programming and rentals not being affected.

FINANCE

- Adoption of the new municipal Procurement Policy.
- Delegation of power authorizing the Chief Administrative Officer to draft and execute municipal procurement contracts with a maximum value of \$99,999.
- Appointment of Sonia Coll as Deputy Treasurer of the Corporation of the Town of Hearst.

POLICY

- Delegation of power authorizing the Chief Administrative Officer to authorize the approval and execution of commercial lease renewals with tenants of the municipal property located at 801 George Street, provided that the renewal maintains substantially the same terms and conditions as the existing lease.
