



SUMMARY OF MUNICIPAL COUNCIL MEETING OF JUNE 30, 2026

FINANCE

- Postponement of consideration Notre-Dame Hospital's request to share the legal costs associated with drafting updated Physician Incentive Agreements, in order to allow for further review and ensure that any decision does not compromise physician recruitment efforts.
- Tax rebate program for the land and building owned and occupied by *Club Action Hearst*.
- Tax rebate program for the land and building owned and occupied by the Hearst Community Curling Club.
- Cancellation of tax arrears for the properties known as Custom Sawmill, totalling \$5,704.22 for 2026.
- Execution of agreement with Mylène Glazer for janitorial services at the Centre Éducatôt Hub, for a period of five years.

POLICY

- Support to the *Corridor Voice* project, recognizing its importance for access to reliable, bilingual local and regional information throughout the Highway 11 corridor.
- Appointment of Éric Picard as director of the North Cochrane Provincial Offences Act Management Board.
- Delegation of authority to the Chief Administrative Officer to authorize changes to parking meters located in the Parking Meter Zone, when such changes are of an administrative or operational nature and comply with Council-approved policies, regulations and budgets.
- Renewal of Donald Gratton's appointment as director of the Hearst Non-Profit Housing Corporation, for a term ending on June 30, 2029.



PLANNING

- Renewal of Michel Blais's appointment as volunteer firefighter of the Town of Hearst Fire Department.
