



SUMMARY OF MUNICIPAL COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 25, 2026

FINANCE

- Amendment to the Cemetery Fee Schedule to reflect the prescribed Care and Maintenance Fund contributions as being included within the interment rights sale price, rather than listed as a separate fee, effective September 1st, 2026.



ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Authorization to hold the Youth Entrepreneurship Challenge annually in both official languages and to allocate an additional budget of \$2,700 to cover the shortfall for the 2026 edition, to be funded from the contingency fund included in the 2026 budget.

POLICY

- Participation of two elected officials at the 2027 ROMA conference designated as a priority commitment in the 2027 budget, for a total amount of \$12,900.
- Effective October 1st, 2026, modification of the Municipal Landfill Site's operating hours to forty (40) hours per week, year-round, according to the following schedule: Tuesday to Friday, from 10 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., and Saturday, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., with the site closed on Sundays and Mondays.
- Amendment to the current salary grid to include an annual salary for the existing Assistant By-law Officer position, based on a 40-hour work week.

PARKS AND RECREATION

- Denial of the Hearst Minor Hockey Association's request for an additional reduction of the ice rental rate for its development camp scheduled from August 31st to September 3rd, 2026.
